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Capped costs for basic replacement equipment and basic installation

Income-qualified participants are eligible for a full-cost replacement, up to the set capped cost which includes the cost of the replacement equipment and installation, sales tax, solid fuel fees (if applicable), permit fees, and removal/recycling costs. The customer must work with one of the program-approved contractors listed on the front page. This is a point-of-sale incentive, so the Clean Air Agency will reimburse the contractor up to the costs listed below for the type of replacement you chose. Any utility rebates offered are included in this capped cost, and any utility incentive must be applied to the cost of the equipment. See the contractors on the front page marked with ♦ and/or ❖ who can provide point-of-sale rebates from Tacoma Power or Puget Sound Energy. If you select a contractor not affiliated with your utility, you must submit the required paperwork to your utility **after the heating** equipment is installed to receive the utility rebate. Costs for devices marked “#” may exceed the allowed capped cost. If you choose a more expensive device than what is covered by the capped cost, you are responsible for all cost differences.
