

SECOND AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This amended agreement is entered into by and between the **Puget Sound Clean Air Agency**, (hereinafter referred to as the "Agency"), a municipal corporation of the laws of the State of Washington, and **Northwest Clean Air Agency** (hereinafter referred to as the "Northwest Clean Air Agency"), 1600 South Second Street, Mount Vernon, WA 98273-5202

WHEREAS, the Agency and Northwest Clean Air Agency entered into Interlocal Agreement 2012033-0-IAA dated August 8, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Agency and Northwest Clean Air Agency entered into the First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement 2012033-1-IAA dated November 5, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency deems it desirable to amend the First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement 2012033-1-IAA, for the purpose of the Agency extending the time period it will perform air monitoring services for the Northwest Clean Air Agency; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agency and the Northwest Clean Air Agency mutually agree as follows:


1. The last sentence of Section 4, "Term," shall be replaced with the following: "The termination date of this Agreement is June 30, 2014."
2. Except as expressly modified above, all terms and conditions of Interlocal Agreement 2012033-0-IAA shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed.


Both signing parties below represent that they have the full right, power and authority to execute this Agreement.


