

AMENDED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This amended Interlocal Agreement is entered into by and between the **Puget Sound Clean Air Agency**, (hereinafter referred to as the "Agency"), a municipal corporation of the laws of the State of Washington, and the **Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department** (hereinafter referred to as the "Health Department"), 3629 South D St., Tacoma, WA 98418-6813.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency deems it desirable to amend the original Interlocal Agreement No. 2014011-0-IAA dated November 6, 2013, for the services of the Health Department to perform Wood Smoke Reduction Program (Program) customer service administration, review applications to determine income-qualified status under the Agency's Program, and provide community outreach and engagement in the Tacoma-Pierce County fine particulate nonattainment area for the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department represents and warrants that it is available, experienced, and qualified to perform said amended services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agency and the Health Department mutually agree as follows:

I. Interlocal Agreement No. 2014011-0-IAA is amended as follows:

1. In Section 1, "Purpose and Scope of the Agreement," sub-section B.3.b, "Duties of Health Department," is replaced with the following:
 - b. For complete Income-Qualifying Applications, the Health Department shall compare annual household income stated in the Income-Qualifying Application, as verified by the supporting documentation, with the following thresholds to determine whether and applicant qualifies as a low-income customer in the Program:

80% of the 2014 Pierce County Area Median Family Income (MFI) (low income)

Household Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Annual Income (equal or less than)	\$37,550	\$42,900	\$48,250	\$53,600	\$57,900	\$62,200	\$66,500	\$70,800

After January 1, 2015, when the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development updates the MFI annual threshold, the Agency and the Health Department will coordinate to update the Program's Income-Qualifying Application with the 2015 threshold.

2. In Section 2, "Compensation," the first paragraph is replaced with the following:
 The total amount paid by the Agency for satisfactory performance of the work under this Interlocal Agreement shall not exceed \$200,000. Funding for this Interlocal Agreement is provided by the Agency's civil penalties fund, strategic

initiatives fund and/or the FY14-15 WSRP Ecology grant G1400211 and is included in the Agency's Wood Smoke work plans for FY14 and FY15.

- 3. In Section 4, "Communications," the Health Department project manager is replaced with the following:
