



IT KEEPS GETTING EASIER...

...TO QUALIFY FOR ScRAPs

The ScRAPs Program is changing! Trucks with a combined total of 200 or more trips annually to The Northwest Seaport Alliance (Port of Seattle and/or Port of Tacoma terminals) can now qualify for the program. Owners can have any combination of trips to the two ports, as long as they have made 200 or more in the last year.

The ScRAPs 2 Program, operated by the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency, helps truck owners upgrade to a cleaner truck. We'll provide up to \$27,000 to eligible owners who scrap old trucks and buy a truck with a 2007 or newer engine (typically, a model year 2008 or newer truck).

Drayage trucks entering Alliance terminals must meet 2007 federal emissions standards by January 1, 2018. This requirement is aimed at reducing air pollution from port-related sources.


